Main responsibilities and tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitoring maintenance activities of infrastructures, management of non-medical stocks and equipment according to MSF standards. • Ensuring the check and follow-up of facilities under the line manager's supervision through daily visits to the facilities and reporting any anomalies or problems, evaluation of the rehabilitation needs and following up minor building rehabilitation work according to supervisor's instructions; checking that premises observe security norms and monitoring the consumption of mechanical and electrical vehicles/machines/devices. • Planning together with the line manager the required checks and maintenance activities of energy systems/set-up according to MSF standards. • Coordinating and leading the logistics team under his/her responsibility which includes daily supervision, monitoring of the quality of work and the definition of each person's task, drawing up their working schedules; organizing and leading team meetings; participating in the recruitment of team personnel and attending logistics meetings and accounting for his activities.
